Further discussion of the river corridor overlay ensued. The planning commission restated that it has no intention of taking any further action on the river corridor overlay.

Marjorie shared that the select board had an ordinance against marijuana but it didn't go far enough for what they intended. A new ordinance is being worked on. Discussion moved to hemp production (which is not illegal).
