John called the meeting to order at 6:31 p.m.

**Public Input** – None

**Approval of Minutes From 4/25/18** – Roger motioned to approve minutes, Tim seconded. Passed unanimously with no changes.

**7B Field Use Request** – Heather Robilotto, pre-school teacher at CES, called John to request that a group her husband is part of be allowed to use the little league field at 7B for about 6 weeks during the fall for a Rutland County youth baseball program. The program serves youth baseball players who want to play a sport but are not interested in fall sports programs provided at the local schools. Roger asked if the group has their own liability insurance. John indicated that he asked that question and was told that they do and can provide proof to the town if needed. After discussion, Roger motioned to approve the group's use of the 7B ballfield pending receipt of the certificate of liability insurance, Tim seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

**Budget Discussion** – The committee discussed use of funds for this fiscal year. The only item that was discussed for purchase in the near future would be bases for the adult softball field in the new recreation area. John is going to find out how to purchase bases through Dick's Sporting Goods that the town would pay for.

**Follow Up from Previous Meeting**

- Dog Park – Matt was going to do more research on the cost of having a dog park installed but he was not present at this meeting to report. Roger agreed to contact Perimeter Solutions by the airport to see if they will give us an estimate on installing a dog park similar to the one in West Rutland.
- Adult softball field – no progress has been made at this time. Tim and Roger were not able to get to the field to install benches but will try to get it done soon.
- Volleyball net – No progress yet but the committee will continue to look into it.
