**Call to Order**

Chairman Klopchin called the meeting to order at 5:35.

**Agenda**

There are no changes or additions to the agenda.

**Teer Rd project discussion**

Road Commissioner Ruane suggested that the board members review the Teer Rd sketch that he provided. Referring to the sketch Ruane outlined the various elements of the plan. There will be two retention ponds. The first pond will be located near the first guardrail as you go up the hill from Walker Mountain Rd. The second pond is located near the end of the road near Walker Mountain Rd. Both ponds will need constant monitoring and routine maintenance of removing debris. Water draining from the pond near the end of the road will filter through a green filtering system before it ends up in the brook. Board members were concerned about the well located near the lower pond. Ruane's opinion was that the well would be safe to use. The ditching on the north side of the road was the next element discussed. The ditching will need to be cleaned and relined with the correct size of rip wrap. Where the ditching is located the road surface will need to be graded to a 3% slope to the north. Culverts are being used to drain the water from the ditches. The east end of the road starting at the lanfear home will need to be crowned to assist in water runoff. The general board discussion of the plan resulted in no changes to the various elements. A suggestion was made that the board needs to somehow budget money to blacktop part of the road. Ruane reported that the amount of money in the Better Roads program was \$20,000. Implementation of the plan should provide better control of stormwater runoff.

The unanimous agreement of the board members was to continue working on this plan. The next step would be to invite the citizens on Teer Road to attend the next board meeting to discuss the plan.

Ambrose agreed to ask Board Administrator Assistant Katie to invite the Teer Rd. citizens.
